TẾT PARADE STREET CLOSURE NOTICE

THERE WILL BE NO PARKING ALLOWED ALONG THE NORTH AND SOUTH SIDE OF BOLSA AVENUE BETWEEN MAGNOLIA STREET AND PURDY STREET ON SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 17, 2018

THE PARADE WILL TAKE PLACE ON SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 17, 2018 AT 9:30 a.m. (Brief program at 9:00 a.m.) THE FOLLOWING STREETS WILL BE CLOSED AT THE TIMES LISTED BELOW:

- On the morning of **Thursday, February 15, 2018**, the Southern Bolsa Avenue Frontage Road between Purdy Street and Neece Street will be closed to through traffic. The area will be used as the parade staging area for TET Parade floats. Access from the Frontage Road to the ABC Market Shopping Center will not be allowed.

- Bolsa Avenue between Newland Street and Magnolia Street (Parade Staging Area)
- Bushard Street between Bolsa Avenue and Bishop Place

7:30 a.m.

- Bolsa Avenue between Magnolia Street and Bushard Street
- Magnolia Street between Greenville Avenue and Bolsa Avenue
- Magnolia Street between Bolsa Avenue and Gables Lane
- Bishop Place between Bushard Street and Belgrade Street

The following street segments will be available for local access only:

7:30 a.m.

- Magnolia Street between Hazard Avenue and Greenville Avenue
- Magnolia Street between Bishop Place and Gables Lane

Residents, business owners, and employees in the Little Saigon area requiring access to the north side of Bolsa Avenue must enter the area by 7:30 a.m. Access to the south side of Bolsa Avenue will be available throughout the event via Bishop Place.
