### **Suspicious Circumstances Turned Medical Aid**

**Date/Time:** November 30, 2014 at 5:56 AM

**Person:** **Andy Quach, 42 yr. old resident of Westminster CA**

**Location:** 15100 block of Brookhurst St., Westminster, CA

On 11/30/2014, at 0556 hrs, officers responded to the 15100 block of Brookhurst St. for suspicious circumstances regarding a man carrying a gun. Upon arrival, officers contacted a resident later identified as Andy Quach. Andy Quach is a current Westminster City Council Member.

Officers determined Quach was in medical distress and summoned the (OCFA) Orange County Fire Authority. OCFA decided to transport Quach to Fountain Valley Hospital for further care. No crime was determined at the scene and there are no other charges pending in this matter. The firearm mentioned was recovered at the scene and taken to WPD for safekeeping.

As with all medical related incidents, no further information regarding the patient will be released at this time.
