Suspects Arrested in Homicide

Date/Time: March 11, 2015, at 1530 hours

Location of Arrest: 22000 block of Blue Bird Dr. Canyon Lake, CA

Victim: Frank Duvall, age 56, resident of Westminster, CA

Suspect #1: Daniel Lee Duvall, age 37, resident of Westminster, CA

Suspect #2: Tina Arbogast, age 45, resident of Westminster, CA

Charges: California Penal Code 187 (homicide) for Duvall
California Penal Code 32 (accessory) for Arbogast

Westminster CA: On 3/8/15, at approximately 10:16 pm, Westminster Police Officers were dispatched to the area of Topaz Street and Sapphire Avenue in reference to a 'man down' in a vehicle. Arriving officers discovered the 56 year old male victim, Frank Duvall, unresponsive in the vehicle and exhibiting signs of trauma. The victim was pronounced dead at the scene by responding personnel from the Orange County Fire Authority. Westminster Police Detectives responded to the scene and conducted a homicide investigation.

UPDATE 3/11/15: Two suspects involved in a homicide in Westminster were taken into custody in Canyon Lake, CA earlier this evening. Duvall and Arbogast were identified as suspects involved in the homicide on 3/8/15 in the area of Topaz St. and Sapphire Ave., Westminster. Detectives suspect Duvall and Arbogast left the scene after the homicide. Detectives later developed information Duvall and Arbogast were in hiding in a residential area in Canyon Lake,

CA. Detectives were able to locate Duval and Arbogast at approximately 3:30 pm and took them into custody without incident.

Daniel Duvall was later booked into the Orange County Jail for homicide, and Tina Arbogast was booked into the Orange County Jail accessory to the homicide.
