This program will provide an opportunity for members of our community to drop off their expired, unused, and unwanted pills free of charge, with no questions asked. The collected drugs will be destroyed.

“Prescription drugs that languish in home medicine cabinets are highly susceptible to diversion, misuse, and abuse”, said Commander Cameron Knauerhaze. The rate of prescription drug abuse is at an all time high. This **Drug Take-Back** event provides our residents a safe way to dispose of their unwanted medication. The Westminster Police Department and the Drug Enforcement Agency encourage community members to take this opportunity and participate in this event. The Drug Enforcement Agency has provided two collection boxes and educational material which will be in the parking lot of the Westminster Civic Center located at 8200 Westminster Blvd., in the City of Westminster.
