Election Update and Information on Voting in the November 8 Election

In addition to a Presidential, Senate, Statehouse, County, and an unprecedented 17 Statewide measures on the November ballot, the City of Westminster is holding a **local** election for Mayor, City Council members, and Measure SS, the Westminster Police/9-1-1/ Essential City Services Measure. Please participate! Here's how you can VOTE:

1. MAIL YOUR BALLOT

Returned ballots post-marked on or before Election Day, November 8, will be accepted provided ballots are received by November 11, 2016. You can take your envelope with the ballot sealed inside to a US Post Office and get it postmarked.

2. VOTE EARLY

California law allows voters to cast their ballot prior to Election Day. You may drop off your ballot, vote in person, get a replacement ballot, or obtain voter assistance at any of the Pre-Election Day Voting Centers in the county.

3. VOTE on ELECTION DAY: NOVEMBER 8, 2016

Polls open at 7:00am and close at 8:00pm. Absentee ballots can be dropped off at any Westminster or Orange County polling place on Election Day. At any of these Polling Places, any Westminster registered voter will be able to vote in person, request a replacement provisional ballot,

Official Measure SS Ballot Question

SS

City of Westminster, Westminster Police/9-1-1/ Essential City Services Measure

To address state takeaways of local funds, protect property values, drinking water supplies and prevent cuts to: 9-1-1 response times; police officers/firefighters/paramedics; drug/gang prevention, domestic violence/sex crimes/human trafficking units; and other general city services, shall an ordinance establishing a 1% transactions and use (sales) tax, expiring December 31, 2022, providing estimated \$13.9 million annually, requiring audits, citizens' oversight, all funds remaining in Westminster, be adopted?

What your vote means:

YES

A "Yes" vote is a vote in favor of authorizing the transactions and use tax for a period of six years.

NO

A "No" vote is against authorizing the transactions and use tax.
