



CITY OF WESTMINSTER HOMELESS PREVENTION AND RAPID-REHOUSING PROGRAM

WE DO NOT HAVE MOTEL VOUCHERS. THIS PROGRAM IS FOR WESTMINSTER RESIDENTS WITH A VERIFIABLE WESTMINSTER ADDRESS OR CHILDREN IN WESTMINSTER SCHOOLS

The City of Westminster can provide homeless prevention services to low-income Westminster residents and/or adults who currently have a child enrolled in the Westminster School District, or current residents living in Westminster and facing eviction. The purpose of the HPRP Program is to provide assistance to those that are homeless or at risk of being homeless. In order to qualify, the following criteria must be met below:

Who qualifies for the HPRP Program?

- Low-income Westminster residents (see table below) and/or families that currently have a child/children enrolled in the Westminster School District
- Household must be homeless (living in a motel, garage, shelter, car, etc.), or
- At risk of being homeless (received eviction notice, losing permanent housing, etc.)
- The household lacks the financial resources to obtain immediate housing or remain in its existing housing

What services are provided through the HPRP Program?

- Short-term or medium-term rental assistance (case by case basis)
- Security or utility deposits
- Housing relocation and stabilization services
- Rent Subsidization (case by case basis)
- Rental assistance for a first month at a location
- Moving costs assistance
- Case management
