The Westminster Housing Authority was established by City Council Resolution 4344 on February 9, 2011 in accordance with California Housing Authority Law, the Bylaws and Rules of Procedure established by Westminster Housing Authority Resolution 1 on May 11, 2011, and amended by Resolution 6 on March 28th, 2012. The Westminster Housing Authority convenes as needed, generally jointly with the City Council, which convenes the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month at 7 p.m. The Mayor, the Council, and two tenants within the Westminster Housing Authority jurisdiction (one which is to be over age 62) shall serve as board members.
