NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on April 22, 2026, the City Council of the City of Westminster introduced an Ordinance entitled:

ORDINANCE NO. 2635

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTMINSTER, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 2.04.075 (STUDY SESSIONS) OF THE WESTMINSTER MUNICIPAL CODE

The purpose of the proposed ordinance is to amend Westminster Municipal Code Section 2.04.075 (Study Sessions) to remove the prohibition on televising or videotaping City Council study sessions. The ordinance ensures consistency with updated teleconferencing requirements under the Ralph M. Brown Act, as amended by Senate Bill 707.

The City Council will conduct a second reading and adopt the Ordinance at its Regular Meeting on May 13, 2026, scheduled to commence at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.
